FERRY INFORMATION

There is complete info at www.wsdot.wa.gov/ferries for Bainbridge, Bremerton and Kingston boat times and fares. Approx ride times: ~35 min for Bainbridge, ~60 min for Bremerton, ~25 min for Kingston.

Call the Coleman dock at 206-464-6400 24 hours in advance to get a reservation for a team. You must arrive 30 minutes prior but you are put in a special lane. This alleviates the stress of making the ferry.

BAINBRIDGE ISLAND

From Seattle: Take Bainbridge ferry. Drive straight off ferry and follow Hwy 305 to High School Road. Turn left onto High School Road & proceed straight through the round-about. Turn right into the lower parking lot after passing the high school on your right. Bus should off load by the tennis courts as there isn't room to turn around behind the stadium.

From South Sound: Take Hwy 16 West to Hwy 3 North to Hwy 305 South (Bainbridge Is./Kingston exit.) Continue on Hwy 305 across Agate Pass Bridge & onto Bainbridge Island. Turn right onto High School Road & proceed straight through the round-about. Turn right into the lower parking lot after passing the high school on your right. Bus should off load by the tennis courts as there isn't room to turn around behind the stadium.

Note: To access the grass fields, follow walkway around the baseball diamond. Grass field is located between the baseball & softball fields.

Take 405 south. Take exit #13B, NE 8th Street. Head West on NE 8th (towards the tall buildings) Turn Left on Bellevue Way. Turn left on SE Wolverine Way/Kilmarnock (this is a steep hill). BHS is at the top of this hill.

From the south:

Take 405 north. Take exit #13B, NE 8th Street. Head West on NE 8th (towards the tall buildings) Turn Left on Bellevue Way. Turn left on SE Wolverine Way/Kilmarnock (this is a steep hill). BHS is at the top of this hill.

From the west/ferries:

Take I90 West. Take Bellevue Way exit. Turn right on SE Wolverine Way/Kilmarnock (this is a steep hill). BHS is at the top of this hill.

Chinook Middle School

From the ferries:

Take I5 North to 520 East to 405 South. Take exit #13B, NE 8th Street. Head West on NE 8th (towards the tall buildings). Turn Right on 100th Left on 18th. Right on 96th Field will be on your right, just at the bend in the road.

From the north:

Take 405 south. Take exit #13B, NE 8th Street. Head West on NE 8th (towards the tall buildings). Turn Right on 100th Left on 18th. Right on 96th Field will be on your right, just at the bend in the road.

From the south:

Take 405 north. Take exit #13B, NE 8th Street. Head West on NE 8th (towards the tall buildings). Turn Right on 100th Left on 18th. Right on 96th Field will be on your right, just at the bend in the road.

CURTIS

From Southbound I-5: Take I-5 S to the 56th Street Exit West. Go left at the traffic lights and then a quick right onto 56th St. Travel west on 56th (it becomes Cirque Drive) for approximately 3.25 miles to Bridgeport Way West. Turn right and travel north to 40th Street. Turn left on 40th street and travel west through the four-way stop at Sunset Drive and down the hill. School is on the right-hand side of the street. The entrance to the stadium south parking lot is the second driveway past the Curtis HS reader board. In order to park on the north side of the stadium continue on 40th and make a right turn on Olympic Drive. Turn right at Grandview Drive (roundabout). Turn right at the driveway just past the baseball field.

From Eastbound 16: Take the Bridgeport Way exit (first exit after the bridge). Take a right at the light. Follow Bridgeport Way going south to 40th St. Turn right on 40th and travel west through the four-way stop at Sunset Drive and down the hill. School is on the right-hand side of the street. The entrance to the stadium south parking lot is the second driveway past the Curtis HS reader board. In order to park on the north side of the stadium continue on 40th and make a right turn on Olympic Drive. Turn right at Grandview Drive (roundabout). Turn right at the driveway just past the baseball field.

From the south via I-405 N:

At Exit 11, take ramp right for I-90 east towards Spokane. At Exit 11B, take ramp right for 148th Ave SE toward Bellevue Community College. Bear right onto 148th Ave SE. At Exit 11B, take ramp right for 148th Ave SE toward Bellevue Community College. Bear right onto 148th Ave SE. Take a right on SE 22nd St. Parking lot is on the right.

The turf field is behind the school on 25th Avenue, between Jefferson and Alder.

From the south:

Take I-5 north towards Seattle. Take exit 164A for Dearborn St towards James St/Madison St, .5 mi. Follow signs for Dearborn St, .1 mi. Turn right at S Dearborn St, .4 mi. Turn left at Rainier Ave, .3 mi. Turn right at S Jackson, .6 mi. Turn left at 23rd Ave S. School will be on your right.

From the north:

Take I-5 towards Seattle. Take exit 168B on the left to merge onto WA-520 east. Take Montlake Blvd exit toward UW. Turn right at E Montlake Pl E. Continue onto 24th Ave E. Continue onto 23rd Ave E. School will be on your left.

HOLY NAMES

Warren G. Magnuson Park

From I-5 exits:

NE 45th St. (Exit #169):

Go east on NE 45th St., past the UW campus, heading down hill. At bottom of hill, turn left at stoplight. Continue east on NE 45th St. which bears left/north becoming Sand Point Way NE. Continue on Sand Point Way NE about 2 miles (passing Children's Hospital). At NE 65th St., turn right into park entrance. NOTE: You do NOT want the main entrance, which is at NE 74th. From the park entrance, follow the directions below.

NE 65th St. (Exit # 171):

Go east on NE 65th St (stay on the arterial!) approx. 4 miles until you cross Sand Point Way NE into the park entrance. From the park entrance, follow the directions below.

From SR 520:

Take the Montlake Blvd. exit (north); continue north on Montlake Blvd. about 1 mile. Bear right as Montlake Blvd. becomes NE 45th St. Continue east on NE 45th St., which bears left/north becoming Sand Point Way NE. Continue on Sand Point Way NE about 2 miles (passing Children's Hospital). At NE 65th St, turn right into park entrance. From the park entrance, follow the directions below.

From I-90:

Take I-5 north to NE 45th St. (Exit #169) or to NE 65th St. (Exit #171) and follow the directions above.

From the park entrance:

After entering the NE 65th St entrance, turn left at Usn Base Road (the second left!!) and continue past the baseball diamonds. Turn right at the big parking lot. You will see a sign for the Sports Meadow. Follow the path at the end of the parking lot to the Sports Meadow (about 1/8 mile).

LAKE SAMMAMISH

\$1 daily parking fee - self-pay machines in parking lots; cars will be ticketed if parking stub not displayed

Please allow extra time for traffic. Directions given are at posted speeds and do not account for bad traffic. The ride can be a quick 30-45 minutes from Seattle or it can easily be more than 1 hour from the ferries. Take time to listen to traffic reports--AM radio, KIRO 710 or KOMO 1000 every 10 minutes. XM Radio Channel 220 also gives traffic reports every few minutes.

Note that the routes below will take you off 520 East sooner than in previous years. This will hopefully help you avoid traffic that can back up at the West Lake Sammamish Pkwy exit off 520 East.

From Seattle via I-5 North or I-5 South (20-25 minutes at posted speeds):

Take 520 East for approx. 9 miles to NE 40th Street exit, then follow ramp for NE 51st Street. Turn right onto NE 51st Street and follow to the end (approx. 1 mi.). Turn left onto West Lake Sammamish Parkway. Turn right at the next traffic light into Marymoor Park onto the main park road, Marymoor Way. Follow park road 1 mile or less turning right into Parking Lot G for fields #7 through #9. Pay parking fee (Field #7 is on your right). Turn right and park at the end. As you look at the fields, Field #9 is on the left.

From Bainbridge/Bremerton-Seattle Ferry to I-5 North or I-90 East (45-50 minutes at posted speeds):

Turn right onto Alaskan Way South, follow ¼ mile and turn left onto S. Atlantic Street (the next street AFTER Royal Brougham). Continue past Safeco Field, up the ramp, following signs for I-5 and I-90. At this point,

depending on traffic, you can take I-5 North and follow directions as above from Seattle via I-5. OR you can take I-90 East to I-405 North (7 mi.) to 520 East (3 mi.) and follow as above (from Seattle). If I-405 is backed up, you can stay on I-90 East to Exit 13 (2 ½ mi.) (see directions below).

From I-90 East or I-90 West (Issaquah) (20-25 minutes at posted speeds):

Follow I-90 to Exit 13, following ramp to West Lake Sammamish Parkway. Follow W. Lake Samm Pkwy for approximately 8-9 miles, bearing right at the end at traffic light ("The Marymoor" senior housing is on the left) and continuing on W. Lake Samm Pkwy for approx. ½ mile and turn right at light into Marymoor Park. Follow main park road, Marymoor Way, 1 mile or less turning right into Parking Lot G for fields #7 through #9. Pay parking fee (Field #7 is on your right). Turn right and park at the end. As you look at the fields, Field #9 is on the left.

Take I-5 N. Take exit number 175- towards WA-523/N.E. 145th ST. At the end of the exit ramp go left onto 145th. Go a few lights and turn LEFT onto 1st AVE NE. The field is on the left. Parking is on the right. Bus info: Buses park in the "Stimson Lot" A gravel lot on the Right hand side of 1st Ave NE next to the soccer field. Large buses should park along 1st Ave. NE (left hand side of the road) CAUTION: Do not park large buses in the "NORTH LOT" They can/will get high centered.

Take I 90 East. After crossing floating bridge onto Mercer Island, exit at Island Crest Way (#7B). LEFT on SE 40th St. RIGHT on 86th Ave. LEFT on 42nd St. LEFT into stadium parking lot

From Eastside:

Take I 90 West. After crossing east Channel bridge onto Mercer Island, exit at Island Crest Way. LEFT onto Island Crest Way. LEFT on SE 40th ST. RIGHT on 86th Ave. LEFT on 42nd St. Left into stadium parking lot.

NATHAN HALE

From I-5 northbound: take the 85th/ Lake City Way Exit. Merge onto Lake City Way. Turn Right on NE 110th. The field is on the corner of NE 110th and 34th Ave NE. Parking is on the street.

From I-5 southbound: Take the Northgate Way exit. Go east on Northgate way. Turn right on Lake City Way. At the next light go left onto 110th. The field is on the corner of NE 110th and 34th Ave NE. Parking is on the street.

From ferry: Follow signs to get on I-5 northbound. Take the 85th/Lake City Way exit. Merge onto Lake City Way. Turn right (east) at the light at NE 110th. The field is on the corner of NE 110th and 34th Ave NE. Parking is on the street.

ROOSEVELT

From SR-520:

Take the Montlake Blvd exit. At the end of the ramp, turn right onto Montlake Blvd (north) and continue ~1mile. Bear right (east) as Montlake Blvd becomes NE 45th St. (by University Village). The street curves left and continues north and becomes Sandpoint Way NE. Continue on Sandpoint Way NE ~2.5 miles. At NE 74th Street turn right into Magnuson Park. Continue straight through a couple of intersections and you will see a parking lot on the right.

Park at the east end of the parking lot near the play structures. You should see signs for the path to the Sports Meadow to the right of the play structure. Follow the path to the Sports Meadow and the lacrosse fields.

From I-5 Northbound:

Take #170 (NE 65th St). At the end of the ramp, take a soft left onto 8th Ave NE headed north. Take a right onto NE 65th St. (east). Continue on NE 65th St for several miles. Stay on the main arterial. At the top of a big hill, bear right onto 49th Ave/NE Princeton Way. It then curves around to the left and becomes NE 65th St as it curves again to the right. Continue on NE 65th St down the hill. Turn left onto Sandpoint Way NE. At NE 74th St turn right into Magnuson Park. Continue straight through a couple of intersections and you will see a parking lot on the right.

Park at the east end of the parking lot near the play structures. You should see signs for the path to the Sports Meadow to the right of the play structure. Follow the path to the Sports Meadow and the lacrosse fields.

From I-5 Southbound:

Take exit #171 (NE 70th St & NE 65th St). At the end of the ramp, take a left and go back over I-5. Turn right onto Roosevelt Way NE (south). Turn left onto NE 65th St (east). Continue on NE 65th St for several miles. Stay on the main arterial. At the top of a big hill, bear right onto 49th Ave NE/NE Princeton Way. It then curves around to the left and becomes NE 65th St as it curves again to the right. Continue on NE 65th St down the hill. Turn left onto Sandpoint Way NE. At NE 74th St turn right into Magnuson Park. Continue straight through a couple of intersections and you will see a parking lot on the right.

Park at the east end of the parking lot near the play structures. You should see signs for the path to the Sports Meadow to the right of the play structure. Follow the path to the Sports Meadow and the lacrosse fields.

From the south:

Take exit 169 toward NE 50th St. Turn left onto NE 50th St. Take NE 50th west one mile to Greenlake Way N. Take a right onto Greenlake Way N. Field and parking lot is on the left.

SNOHOMISH

Snohomish – Harvey Airfield

10530 Airport Way – Southwest corner of Harvey Airfield Unlighted Grass field

From the I-5 corridor :

From I-5 (north or south) take the #186 exit (128th St). From the exit ramps make the appropriate turn to head East. Proceed straight for 6.1 miles to Hwy. 9 and turn left (North) onto Hwy 9. From this point, continue North for 2.3 miles, down the long hill into the Snohomish valley, to the second traffic light in the middle of the valley. Turn right at the light onto Airport Way. Drive about 200 yards and turn left at the end of this road. Slow down, proceed 0.1 miles, and look toward your left for the entrance to the lacrosse fields at the Southwest corner of Harvey airfield. Pull into and park inside the fenced area - not along the roadside.

From Bellevue / Eastside, I-405 corridor :

Take I-405 North to the Woodinville / Bothell interchange. Exit onto Route 522 heading East toward Wenatchee / Monroe for 2.8 miles and exit onto Hwy 9. Turn left (North) onto Hwy 9 toward Snohomish and proceed for 8.3 miles to Airport Way (in the middle of the Snohomish valley). Turn right at the light onto Airport Way. Drive about 200 yards and turn left at the end of this road. Slow down, proceed 0.1 miles, and look toward your left for the entrance to the lacrosse fields at the Southwest corner of Harvey airfield. Pull into and park inside the fenced area - not along the roadside.

Snohomish – Glacier Peak High School

From the I-5 corridor :

From I-5 (north or south) take the #186 exit (128th St). From the exit ramps make the appropriate turn to head East. Proceed straight for 4.8 miles to the traffic light at 144th Pl SE. Turn left onto 144th Pl SE, drive approximately 200 feet and take the first left into the Staff / Student Parking driveway. Drive straight to the end of the lane until you see the tennis courts on the right and park there. Look for and walk toward the tall stadium lights.

From Bellevue / Eastside, I-405 corridor :

Take I-405 North to the Woodinville / Bothell interchange. Exit onto Route 522 heading East toward Wenatchee / Monroe for 2.8 miles and exit onto Hwy 9. Turn left (North) onto Hwy 9 toward Snohomish and proceed for 5.9 miles to Cathcart Way. At the traffic light turn left (West) onto Cathcart Way and proceed for 1.3 miles to 144th Pl SE. At the traffic light turn right onto 144th Pl SE, drive approximately 200 feet and take the first left into the Staff / Student Parking driveway. Drive straight to the end of the lane until you see the tennis courts on the right and park there. Look for and walk toward the tall stadium lights.

Snohomish - Snohomish High School

From the I-5 corridor :

From I-5 (north or south) take the #186 exit (128th St). From the exit ramps make the appropriate turn to head East. Proceed straight for 6.1 miles to Hwy. 9 and turn left (north) onto Hwy 9. From this point, continue 3.2 miles north and cross the Snohomish valley. At the north end of the valley slow down as you cross the Snohomish River bridge and take the first exit ramp to the right after the bridge. Make a right turn at the stop sign and head east on Second St. to the first traffic light and turn left (north) onto Ave. D. Proceed north on Ave. D for 0.5 miles to 7th St. and turn left. The lighted High School Stadium is ahead about 500 feet on the left with open parking to the right.

From Bellevue / Eastside, I-405 corridor :

Take I-405 north to Woodinville/Bothell interchange. Exit onto Route 522 heading east toward Wenatchee / Monroe for 2.8 miles and exit onto Hwy 9. Turn left (north) onto Hwy 9 toward Snohomish and proceed for 9.2 miles. This will bring you to the Snohomish river bridge. Just after crossing the river, take the first exit ramp to the right. Make a right turn at the stop sign and head east on Second St. to the first traffic light and turn left (north) onto Ave. D. Proceed north on Ave. D for 0.5 miles to 7th St. and turn left. The lighted High School Stadium is ahead about 500 feet on the left with open parking to the right.

Snohomish - Cavelero Mid High School

From the I-5 corridor (Including Bellevue, Eastside, and the I-405 corridor :

From I-5 (north or south) take the Hwy 2 exit in Everett (exit #194). From the exit ramps make the appropriate turn to head East on Hwy 2 toward Snohomish / Wenatchee – you'll be driving 3.1 miles. Once on Hwy 2 stay in the center lane (of the three lanes) to line up to exit onto 20th St. SE and proceed straight up the hill (do not exit toward Snohomish or Lake Stevens). At 3.1 miles from I-5 you'll come to the second traffic light at 83rd Ave. SE. Turn right onto 83rd Ave SE and proceed 0.4 miles to the entrance to the school on the left. As you turn into the parking lot, the turf field is to the left of the school building and behind the baseball field.

TACOMA TIGERS

Mason Middle School

From the North, South or East:

Take I-5 to Tacoma, take exit #133 City Center exit. Follow signs to the Schuster Parkway (bearing right). Stay on the Schuster parkway (get in left hand lane), follow sign for N. 30th St (get in right lane). Go through 1 stop light and head up a big hill. Go to 2nd stop light and turn left onto N. Proctor. You will see Mason MS on your right. Turn right (after Mason MS) onto N. 28th St. The field in the back of the school.

From the West:

Follow Highway 16 east across the Narrows Bridge. Take the Pearl St. Exit #3 (towards WA 163N/Ruston). Turn right on Pearl and an immediate right at the 1st light onto 6th Ave. Go approx 1.2 mi to N. Proctor and make a left. Proceed another 1 mile to N. 28th St and make a left. The field is behind the school.
